- The symposium is organized by no more than three individuals
- The symposium organizer(s) are current VSS members (Invited speakers need not be members, but they must register for the conference, which is more affordable for members than non-members)
- The symposium has 4-6 talks and a 2-hour format
- In planning the symposium, organizers considered scientific merit, theoretical and/or methodological innovation, timeliness, breadth and appeal to a substantial number of VSS attendees, as well as a lack of overlap with the regular program and recent symposia
- In planning the symposium, the diversity of perspectives, career stages, and institutional affiliations was considered
- All speakers have agreed to participate in the symposium if it is accepted
- No speakers have agreed to participate in any other symposium proposal
- All speakers have agreed that they will register for the meeting (at their own expense) and attend the conference in person if their symposium is accepted (as there is no virtual component)
- Any talks with multiple authors will be presented by the first author
- Organizers and speakers understand that speaker substitutions are not allowed
